

## Behaviour Guidance Policy

### Policy Statement

Rose Garden teachers will positively model, reinforce and guide appropriate behaviour whilst maintaining children's dignity and respect.

### Rationale

To ensure adults give positive guidance and have consistent approaches to supporting children's behaviour.

### Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage

- PSED, Managing feelings and behaviour: Children talk about how they and others show feelings, talk about their own and others' behaviour, and its consequences, and know that some behaviour is unacceptable. They work as part of a group or class, and understand and follow the rules. They adjust their behaviour to different situations, and take changes of routine in their stride.
- 3.52. Providers are responsible for managing children's behaviour in an appropriate way. Providers must not give corporal punishment to a child.
- 3.53. Providers must not threaten corporal punishment, and must not use or threaten any punishment which could adversely affect a child's well-being.

### Procedures

1. All adults are expected to role-model acceptable behaviours (e.g. gentle hands, kind words, sitting while eating, appropriate interactions and communication, and resolving conflict peacefully).
2. Teachers (and where appropriate other adults) will be consistent in guiding acceptable behaviours, taking into account individual children's developmental stage, individual needs and temperament.
3. Teachers will work together with parents to develop individual behaviour plans and access external support agencies where necessary.
4. All relief staff working with and alongside children will receive information regarding behaviour guidance.
5. The behaviour guidance procedures outlined in the 'Behaviour Guidance at Rose Garden' document will be implemented at all times.
6. The 'Managing Behaviour' regulations outlines in the Statutory Framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage will be upheld at all times.
