## Practical information for Parents/ Carers attending groups

## Waterproofs

During outside play, children will be able to play in mud, sand and water. They will be most comfortable in waterproof clothes and boots - we have some you can borrow, if you don't have any.

## Mobile phones

Please keep them in your bags and not use them in the session, unless in an emergency.

## Photos & Videos

Please do not record any images on your mobile phone or camera without permission from the group leader.

## Social Distancing

Please maintain social distancing throughout the session.

#### Hygiene Practices

Adults and children are encouraged to sanitise or wash their hands on arrival to and departure, before and after using the toilet, and before and after eating. Please bring your own changing mat/blanket if you need one.

## First Aid

Children remain the responsibility of the parent/carer at all times. A first aid kit will be available at all times to enable parents to care for their child. If an adult requires first aid, they will be offered the Centre's first aid kit or the group leader will seek medical assistance.

#### Refreshments

Warm drinks, water, unprepared fruit will be provided for you. You are welcome to bring your own food. Food and drink should not be shared between families.

#### Singing and snack

Please bring a blanket to sit on for ring time. There is plenty of room for us to socially distance. Towards the end of the session we will come together for snack time and singing.

#### Illness

Please monitor yourself and members of your household carefully and mindfully. Should any symptoms of COVID-19 present themselves \*Do not come to the session\*

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss of, or change to, your sense of smell or taste

All occurrences of COVID-19 which are confirmed (through a positive test result) within your household, must be reported to Rose Garden without delay.
